On June 23-24, 2017 Team McAllen Cycling will be riding on behalf of Spina Bifida Texas. This organization is based in San Antonio and is committed to serving individuals affected by Spina Bifida in Central and South Texas including the Rio Grande Valley.

The mission of SBTX is to improve the lives of those affected by Spina Bifida and to promote its prevention through folic acid awareness. Spina Bifida is a birth defect that occurs when the lower end of the spinal cord does not form properly in the developing baby. Paralysis, loss of bowel and bladder control, hydrocephalus (a buildup of fluid in skull that causes brain damage) and learning disabilities are among the many issues associated with this complex disability. It is estimated that **Spina Bifida affects 2 in every 1,000 births in Texas.**

SBTX is committed to preventing this easily preventable birth defect. **If every woman of child bearing age (15-44) would take a vitamin containing 400mcg of folic acid every day, the incidence of Spina Bifida would be reduced by 70%.**
